

616.06 IMPOUNDMENT OF RABID ANIMALS.

Provisions shall be made in each veterinary hospital for securely impounding any animal confined for observation for rabies. Special precautions shall be taken to securely and separately confine any such animal during such period of observation, and a report shall be made to the President of the Board of Health at the time such animal is accepted for confinement and again at the time the animal is released from the hospital. Such animal shall also be vaccinated against rabies before being released.
