



With summertime finally upon us, there are some common violations which are listed below. While this is not a complete list, it includes things that you may want to look at and correct in order to avoid any fines that may incur. Thank you for your cooperation by doing your part in order to keep our city looking beautiful.

<p><b>Important Message</b></p>		<p><b>Important Message</b> Please contact the Building Department at (708) 788-2660 ext. #6462 to update your mailing address and phone number changes to ensure all information is up to date.</p>
<p><b>Accumulations</b></p>		<p>-Maintain the exterior premises free of accumulation of trash, garbage, brush or construction materials that would encourage the infestation of rats, vermin, insects, rodents, and other pests. Garbage lids must be down at all times. *Small <i>non-food bagged items</i> <u>can be</u> placed on the side of the garbage can <i>24 hours</i> before the scheduled pick-up day.</p> <p>⇒For damaged/missing garbage cans or covers, please call Waste Management (708) 656-5350 for free replacement. ⇒For over-sized items and large appliances, please call Waste Management for a special pick-up at (800) 796-9696.</p>
<p><b>Overgrown Grass &amp; Weeds</b></p>		<p>-All premises and exteriors shall be maintained free from grass, weeds, or plant growth more than 10 inches tall.</p> <p>⇒Please trim all bushes and hedges that have grown over the public way.</p>
<p><b>Vehicle Storage</b></p>		<p>No vehicle shall be parked, kept, or stored on any soft ground (gravel/grass). Every parking space should have a hard all weather surface and no vehicle should at any time be in a state of disrepair, disassembly, or in the process of being stripped or dismantled and <u>cannot be left on jack stands.</u></p> <p>⇒ Vehicle tags &amp; stickers must be current.</p>
<p><b>Animals: Urination &amp; Defecation</b></p>		<p>Owners must keep dog or cat on a leash at all times while being walked. Residential properties must be free of domestic animal feces on a daily basis.</p> <p>⇒ If an owner allows dog/cat to defecate on a public street, alley, ground, parkway, or any other private or public property, the owner is responsible for <b>picking up the animal feces from the place of deposit immediately.</b></p>
<p><b>Street Numbers</b></p>		<p>Provide address numbers which must be clearly visible from the street and alley.</p> <p>⇒Numbers must be 3" to 12" in height, contrasting with the mounting surface.</p>
<p><b>Electronics Recycling</b></p>		<p>The City of Berwyn is proud to announce the opening of our electronics recycling center at Public Works located at <b>6700 W. 30th St.</b> [Next to the YMCA].</p> <p>⇒Place electronics in front of the building underneath the recycling sign</p>
