Power Outage - Update

Berwyn, IL – In the early hours of Tuesday, February 6th, a vehicular accident caused damage to four ComEd polls in the south alley of 34th Street between Clarence Ave. and Gunderson Ave. ComEd has had crews on the scene all day, and power has now been restored.

The Police Department has sent auxiliary officers to check on residents. If you have a neighbor that is a senior, please check in on them. If you are worried about the health status of a neighbor, please call our non-emergency number (708) 795-5600.

If you need to keep warm, following are the City's warming centers:

Berwyn Police Department, 6401 W. 31st St – open 24 hours
Berwyn Public Library – 2701 S Harlem Ave – Monday thru Thursday, 9 am to 9 pm
Berwyn Recreation Department, 6501 W. 31st St. – Monday thru Friday, 8 am to 8 pm.

Lastly, once power has been restored, it is important to check all of your utilities (including your hot water tank) and appliances to make sure that they are working correctly after the power outage.
