General Information

▶ Food garbage must be disposed if in the 96 gallon garbage cans and the lid must be closed at all times. *Non-food* items can be placed on the side of the garbage can 24 hours before the scheduled pick up date.

▶ Recycled items must be placed into the 64 gallon totter that has "**Recycling Only**" on lid. Recycling container will not be picked up if they contain normal garbage.

***The City of Berwyn follows the Illinois Statute on fines for improper waste disposal. These fines can range from \$50 -\$750 per day. Follow these simple guidelines to assure that you do not receive citations.

SPECIAL PICK-UP

Oversized items may require a special pick-up by Waste Management.

- ▶ Please contact **Waste Management** before putting any items outside.

Appliances

The City of Berwyn is a "Take All" customer of Waste Management's. You are allowed to put out (1) appliance per week at no charge. For more than one item per week, the fee for more than one appliance is \$20.00 per appliance.

- **Washer • Dehumidifier • Stove • Hot Water Heater • Freezer**
- **Furnace • Air Conditioner • Dryer • Dishwasher • Refrigerator**
- Furniture: Included at no charge with your normal bill. It must be placed out before 6:00 AM on pick-up day but no sooner than 24 hours before pick-up.
- Bulk items are not to exceed 4 cubic yards.

Yard Waste



Seasonal Pick- Up runs April 1st -December 31st

Leaves, grass, etc. will be picked up on your regular pick-up day and must be placed in the options below:

Brown yard waste bags	32 Gallon plastic container with lid can be purchased at any Home Improvement store. *The 32 gallon container must have a " YARD WASTE " Sticker that may be picked up at City Hall.

Acceptable items include grass clippings, leaves, tree branches (broken into a manageable length), and brush. Non-acceptable items include dirt, stone, concrete, rock.



Owners must keep dog or cat on a leash at all times while being walked. Residential properties must be free of domestic animal feces on a daily basis.

If an owner allows dog/cat to defecate on a public street, alley, ground, parkway, or any other private or public property, the owner is responsible for picking up the animal feces from the place of deposit immediately.



GARBAGE GUIDELINES

- Do not mix household refuse with recyclables in the recycling garbage can. Mixed recyclables with refuse will not be collected.
- Do not put recyclable materials in plastic bags.
- All recyclable materials should be rinsed free of food with caps/lids removed
- Cardboard must be flattened or cut in manageable pieces and put into the recycle can and the lid must be able to close.

What's Recyclable?

All acceptable recyclable items can be placed together inside the recycling can for collection.

Glass

Bottles & Jars (Brown, Green & Clear)

Metal

Beverage Cans & Clean Aluminum Foil, Steel or tin cans, Empty Aerosol cans

Paper & Cardboard

Magazines, Telephone Books, Newspaper & all Inserts, Computer & Writing Paper, Junk Mail, Brown Paper Grocery Bags, File Folders, Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Dry Food Boxes such as Cereal, Cake Mix & Cracker Containers, Shoe Boxes, Pizza boxes, Empty Paper Towel & Toilet tissue tubes

Plastic Bottles & Rigid Containers

1 & 2 Liter Soda Bottles, Plastic Flower Pots, Plastic Plates & Trays, Laundry Detergent Containers, Milk & Water Bottles, Margarine Tubs, Baby Wipe Containers, Plastic Cups, Cooking Oil Bottles, Shampoo Bottles, Squeezed Mustard Bottles, Deli Containers, Cosmetic Containers, Six & Twelve Pack Rings

These items may include paint, household cleaners, compact fluorescent lamps (CFL), automotive products, garden chemicals, batteries, electronics and more, that can be conveniently picked up at your home by simply scheduling a collection.

The materials accepted through this program include:



Automotive Products

Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels and more.



Garden Chemicals

Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides and weed killers.



Paint Products

Paint, caulk, glue, stain, stripper, thinner and wood preservative.



Household Cleaners

Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaner, rust remover, tile/shower cleaner, upholstery cleaner and more.



Electronics

Computer, monitor, keyboards, MP3 players, televisions, DVD/CD players, tape players, VCR, cell phones, desktop printers, fax machines and microwaves.



Mercury containing items

Batteries, compact fluorescent lamps, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, and thermostats.



Sharps, needles and lancets

Must be placed in a sealed, rigid, puncture resistant container.
