The City of Berwyn has begun to undertake the replacement of 10 alleys with green infrastructure. Funding for this project has been made possible through a joint effort of the City of Berwyn, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, and the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago.

The purpose of the project is to promote green infrastructure as an effective means of storm water management. The existing alleys currently do not allow for storm water to permeate into the soil and reduce urban runoff. The new alley will allow for storm water to be temporarily stored and then permitted to infiltrate into the subgrade. By allowing the water to infiltrate, this will lessen the amount of urban runoff that enters the sewer system.

Residents that reside in the vicinity of these alleys will receive letters at their doorstep that contain information in regards to parking and street maintenance. Weather-permitting, it should take approximately (5) weeks for each alley to be completed.
