MINUTES
BERWYN CITY COUNCIL
October 28, 2014

1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Polashek, Santoy, Avila and Laureto.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given for the men and women protecting our safety on the streets of Berwyn, in the Armed Forces and for all Veterans.
3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced; The Mayor thanked Firefighter Brian Tokarczyk for assisting the "Love of Lee" project.
4. Minutes of the regular Berwyn City Council meeting and Committee of the Whole held October 14, 2014, were submitted. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.
5. Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian to suspend the rules and bring forward agenda item J-3. The motion carried by a voice vote. J-3 is a communication from the Fire Chief O'Halloran regarding introduction and swearing in of Probationary Firefighter/Paramedic Kevin Conlon. Avila made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur in the appointment. The motion carried by a voice vote. Thereafter, Clerk Pavlik administered the Oath of Office.
6. The Mayor submitted a Proclamation for Richard "Jousef" Mondragon, the 2014 Charles E. Piper award recipient. Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to **adopt** the proclamation as presented. The motion carried a unanimous roll call vote. Thereafter, the Mayor presented the proclamation to Mr. Mondragon and declared November 1, 2014 as Richard "Jousef" Mondragon Day in Berwyn.
7. The Mayor submitted a communication regarding the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District Rain Barrel Program Agreement. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and approve the agreement as presented and authorize the corporate authorities to

affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

8. The Zoning Board of Appeals submitted a communication regarding Request for Conditional Use – Rooftop Antenna Installation – 3201 S. Harlem Avenue and an attached ordinance entitled:

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR AN
ANTENNA INSTALLATION ON A ROOFTOP IN THE C-4
RESTRICTED COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT AT 3201 S.
HARLEM AVENUE, BERWYN, ILLINOIS**

Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and **adopt** the ordinance as presented and authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

9. Alderman Paul submitted a deferred communication regarding the handicap application #901 for 3118 S. Maple. Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to override the staff's recommendation and approve the application. The motion carried by a voice vote.
10. The City Attorney submitted a communication regarding the settlement of Case No. 14CV3639. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to concur and approve for payment in an amount not to exceed \$15,000. The motion carried by the following call of the roll; Yea: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Avila, Laureto. Nay: Polashek.
11. The Assistant City Administrator submitted a communication regarding the 2014 Holiday Decorations RFP-Bid Award. The Mayor recognized Evan Summers who reviewed same, with a fifteen percent (15%) contingency and a recommendation to be awarded to Arte Gardens of Poplar Creek, IL. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur and approve for payment an amount not to exceed \$25,616.25. The motion carried a unanimous roll call vote.
12. The Traffic Engineer submitted a communication regarding the Illinois Green Infrastructure Grants (IGIG) Award, totaling \$2.2 million. The Mayor recognized Nicole Campbell who reviewed same. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to accept as informational and thanked Ms. Campbell for her hard work and dedication. The motion carried by a voice vote.

Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to **adopt** the resolution as presented and authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried with a unanimous roll call vote.
14. The Building Director submitted a communication regarding Chapter 1458 Scaffolding and an attached ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 1458 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERWYN TO REGULATE THE USE OF SCAFFOLDING

- Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Avila, to concur, **adopt** the ordinance as presented and authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
15. Public Works Director submitted a communication regarding a recommendation to award the proposal for the City Hall Parking Lots. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur, award to the lowest bidder Sanchez Paving and approve for payment in the amount not to exceed \$145,506. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
 16. Public Works Director submitted a communication regarding a recommendation to approve the purchase of a One Ton Dump Truck. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur and approve for payment in the amount not to exceed \$35,278.80 and to refer the 2002 Ford Explorer to the Finance Director to declare as surplus. The motion carried with a unanimous roll call vote.
 17. The Interim Library Director submitted a communication requesting authorization to advertise and replace Library Page (15 hours,) to fill a vacancy. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to concur and grant permission. The motion carried by a voice vote.
 18. The Interim Library Director submitted a communication requesting to waive the seal bid and award the contract for snow removal and de-icing services. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to concur and award the contract to Chicago Services Group in an amount not to exceed \$15,675. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

MINUTES
BERWYN CITY COUNCIL
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
October 28, 2014

1. Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 6:00 p.m.; upon the call of the roll the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Santoy and Polashek. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to excuse Aldermen Santoy and Polashek. The motion carried by a voice vote.
2. The Mayor recognized Attorney James Vasselli who presented the ordinance regarding chapter 1458 scaffolding, with revision of section 1458.03.

Note: Santoy present at 6:02 p.m.

Vasselli reviewed the revisions. The Mayor recognized Building Director Charles Lazzara, who explained the need for this ordinance. Alderman Paul stated that she thought the definition of scaffolding was too broad and it can be interpreted as two ladders and a plank as that which would be used by a resident simply painting their garage. Discussion ensued on amending the definition in section 1458.01 to exempt homeowner use. Vasselli stated he would prepare the ordinance with amended language prior to adoption, which is item J-6 on tonight's council agenda.

3. Flood Mitigation Shared Cost Program: The Mayor recognized Traffic Engineer Nicole Campbell who presented and reviewed the proposed program guidelines.
 - Program Goals: Providing financial assistance to homeowners who install flood control systems to prevent sewer backup during heavy rain events.
 - Property Owner Protection: Modification of the plumbing in the building can protect below ground areas due to overflow in the combined sewer system.
 - Items covered under the program/Eligible and non-eligible costs.
 - Program Eligibility: Program is open to owner occupied single family homes as well as owner occupied multi-family residences of 1-3 units. Applications will be received until the funds dedicated to this program have been expended.
 - Procedures: The property owner establishes initial intent to participate by contacting the Engineers Office at a pre designated e-mail account and/or fax number. Plumbing inspector and/or Engineer will undertake building inspections. If the homeowner is ineligible, the Engineer will notify the homeowner. After deemed eligible, the homeowner shall give final notice of intent to participate. The City will review completed application packets and formally reply to property owner of approval or denial. The property

owner shall then authorize a contractor to do the work by executing the contract approved by the City. The contractor shall follow all project requirements. Upon completion of the work, the property owner shall submit a request for a reimbursement form with proof of payment, certification from contractor that work is complete and final inspection from City Inspector. All subject to final review by City Engineer.

Discussion ensued regarding procedures and permit length to complete work, which was determined to be six months. Ms. Campbell noted that she will put together a draft informational brochure and application packets that will be provided to interested residents. Alderman Santoy questioned if the City can provide a list of licensed plumbing contractors, discussion ensued. It was determined that a list will be available from either the Building Department or the Collector's Office upon request. Alderman Paul questioned if it can be retroactive for residents who have already recently installed systems. The Mayor answered, no, it is only from the time the City starts the program and forward. The Mayor stated this will be a first come, first served program. Paul then suggested limiting to especially hard hit areas within the City. Discussion ensued regarding it being open to all eligible residents who wish to participate. Paul questioned procedures and discussion ensued. Thereafter, the Mayor noted the final project requirements will be presented to council at the November 12, 2014 council meeting.

The Mayor then opened it up to the public in attendance for any comments and/or questions.

- A resident commented on the sewer systems being over taxed during a heavy rain incident, noting water being pumped out of one residents home into the sewer system, may only find its way into another home that does not have a flood control system.
- A Grove Ave. resident questioned the right system for his property. Public Works Director Robert Schiller stated he will be available to talk to the resident after the meeting.
- A resident commented about the Deep Tunnel Reservoir Project being completed by 2017 and if this will elevate all the flooding problems in the Western Suburbs. The Mayor stated that it is only the first stage of the Deep Tunnel Reservoir which is scheduled to be opened, but not completed until the year 2020 or 2025. Public Works Director Schiller noted that no matter how large the reservoir is at the end of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District areas sewer systems, the actual combined sewer system leading into the reservoir can only hold so much water and may not be able to drain fast enough into the reservoir to elevate all flooding issues in the event of a large rainfall in a short time period.


- A resident questioned what happens when the original allocated monies are all used up. The Mayor answered that a waiting list will be maintained until additional funding sources can be identified.
- A resident questioned the first come, first served procedures suggesting accepting post marked mail, a city employee or department dedicated to accepting hand delivered application and time stamping them. The Mayor noted that the City will accept by e-mail, hand delivered time stamped and mailed applications.

Note: Polashek present at 7:01 p.m.

Paul suggested expanding the program to cover other options of flood control, i.e. stand pipes or not implementing this program at all and/or dedicating the 1 million in funds for sewer repair in hope of elevating some flooding issues. Discussion ensued. Once again, the Mayor noted that Ms. Campbell will prepare a final draft that will be presented for approval at the next council meeting on November 12th.

4. The Mayor asked if there were any questions or comments about any other agenda items. Alderman Paul thanked Nicole Campbell for her hard work in securing the Illinois Green Infrastructure Grants (IGIG) Award, item J-4 and questioned the MWRD Rain Barrel Program, item F-2. Campbell reviewed same.
5. There being no further business to come before the Committee of the Whole, the Mayor entertained a motion to adjourn. Thereafter, a motion was made by Avila, seconded by Laureto, to adjourn the Committee of the Whole at 7:25 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.

Re: **Renewal of General Liability Insurance**

The City's general liability insurance coverage is set to expire on December 31, 2014. Staff therefore asked our independent insurance brokers, Jim Parrilli and Les Peach, to go out for bid and solicit quotes from carriers. Our current coverage, with carrier Princeton, has a \$10,000,000 limit of liability and a \$250,000 deductible/retention.

Our insurance brokers solicited quotes from two different carriers in addition to Princeton (current carrier.) Princeton came in with the lowest premium in the amount of \$261,070, a 6.6% increase from last year. The industry standard increase from last year is between 4 and 7%.

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the "*City* ") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "*Home Rule Powers*"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Berwyn (the "*Corporate Authorities*") has adopted a Residential Flood Mitigation Shared Cost Pilot Program to assist residents in their efforts to protect their home from sewer backup. This program provides homeowners for costs of upgrading their plumbing in order to minimize sewage backflow; and

WHEREAS, the Homeowner is the owner and occupant of the residence which has been subject to sewer backup; and

WHEREAS, the Homeowner is required to submit an application in order to participate in the program and the City has determined that the Homeowner is eligible to participate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, adopt the Residential Flood Mitigation Shared Cost Pilot Program.

Residential Flood Mitigation Shared Cost Pilot Program Guidelines

Program Goals

The Residential Flood Mitigation Shared Cost Pilot Program was established to provide financial assistance to homeowners who install systems to protect their homes from sewer backup during a heavy rain event. The program's intent is to offset a portion of the expense of modifying a building's plumbing system to prevent backflow when City sewers are at capacity and assistance to homeowners who desire to protect their home from flooding during a heavy rain event.

This is a reimbursement program, in which the homeowners must first receive approval to take part in the program prior to installing a flood mitigation system. Improvements installed prior to approval are not eligible for reimbursement.

To repair or modify building sewer systems, there are three (3) basic options available to the homeowner as follows:

1. Modification of the internal waste piping to direct the flow out of the building in a new OVERHEAD SEWER and the elimination of all gravity drainage below the basement floor (Figure 1),
2. Installation of a BACKFLOW PREVENTION VALVE and BYPASS PUMP on the building lateral in an underground vault installed outside of the building between the building and City sewer main (Figure 2), and
3. Installation of a BACKFLOW PREVENTION VALVE only, on the building lateral outside of the building between the building and City sewer main (Figure 3).

Each of the above approaches has different costs, degrees of disruption and levels of protection.

This Program is designed to assist homeowners in reducing the risk of basement flooding due to sewer backups. However, there is always a risk of a sewer backup as a result of unexpected sewer collapse, obstruction, power failure, extreme environmental or weather conditions or other unforeseen factors, as well as basement flooding due to seepage and other causes. Homeowners assume the risk of loss of any future property damage due to flooding.

Homeowners **are required** to disconnect roof drainage/downspouts and footing drain sump pumps from their sewer system as an integral component of this program except in specific hardship cases where an exemption may be granted by the City.

Prior to the disconnection of the downspouts, the homeowner will be required to schedule a preliminary inspection with the Engineering Department, if the homeowner is interested in the **downspout disconnection or rain barrel programs** offered by the City. Downspouts previously disconnected will not be eligible for the rain barrel or downspout disconnection programs.

Eligible homeowners may qualify for a 50% cost sharing, up to a maximum of \$3,500.00 for installing an overhead sewer system, a backflow prevention valve with a bypass pump or a backflow prevention valve only.

HOMEOWNER PROTECTION

Modification of the plumbing in a building (in many cases) can prevent the backflow of sewage into below ground areas of buildings during times of an overloaded combined sewer system. Installation of pump(s), where required, to lift the building's lower level sewage above the street level will provide this positive protection.

In order to fully protect a basement from flooding, in addition to installing a flood mitigation system, homeowners should make sure foundation drains are operating properly to prevent seepage of ground water through walls below grade. (This

Program does not cover existing foundation drains, and the City will not test them for proper operation under this Program.) The homeowner has the responsibility for all testing, inspections and any corrective work that may become necessary.

Homeowners should also make sure their sump/ejector pump(s) operates reliably. The continuous operation of sump/ejector pump(s) is necessary for the proper functioning of overhead sewers, backflow prevention valves and foundation drains. The homeowner is responsible to check the operation of the pumps regularly. The homeowner is responsible for all testing, inspections and any corrective work that may become necessary after the improvements covered by this Program are installed. Homeowners should also install a battery backup system to provide protection in the event of power failure.

The homeowner owns the sewer service from the house to the sewer main, typically located in the center of the road. The homeowner should perform regular maintenance procedures on their sewer lateral line. Such items are use of root killer in the sewer service and regular sewer service and catch basin cleaning. Homeowners can also take part in the sewer line warranty program.

ITEMS COVERED UNDER THIS PROGRAM

This Program covers Flood Mitigation measures. The following are **Eligible** costs which may be covered as part of this program:

- Cost of location, excavation and exposure of the building sewer, including the support of existing structures, for reconnection to a new overhead sewer to the existing sewer line or for the installation of a clean-out for the purpose of lining the sewer lateral to the City's sewer main.
- Cost of a new pump pit, ejector pump and associated electrical and plumbing works needed to lift the drainage from basement plumbing fixtures to an overhead sewer or existing soil stack.

- Cost of trenching and concrete floor replacement.
- Cost of installing a backflow prevention valve with a bypass (new sump and ejector pump in an underground vault) and associated electrical and plumbing work.
- Cost of grass seeding or sod to restore disrupted landscape.
- New electrical panels and/or upgrading the house electrical supply to power a new sump pump(s).
- Applicable permit fees.

The following are **Non-Eligible** costs which will not be covered by this program:

- Battery backup system.
- Removal and replacement of interior basement walls and finishes.
- Use of materials not meeting the requirements of the City's Specifications or Codes.
- Ancillary homeowner improvements not necessary to provide sewer backup protection of the basement.
- Planting of new or replacement landscaping (bushes and trees) other than grass seeding or sod.
- Homeowner enhancements not necessary to provide sewage backup protection in below grade levels of buildings.
- Costs associated with disconnecting downspouts and roof drains from the City's sewer system.
- Expenses incurred prior to City approval of application packet.
- Inspection fees.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

This program is open to owner occupied single-family homes that are susceptible to sewer backup by way of a gravity sewer line. Single family is defined as both traditional single family homes as well as multi-family residences of 1-3 units where the owner occupies at least one unit. A property will be eligible for this program only once.

Applications will be received until the funds dedicated to this purpose have been expended, afterwards interested applicants will be put on a waiting list until funds are made available.

Homeowners will be considered ineligible if:

- Any unpaid taxes or water bills or other debt is due to the City.
- Any unpaid final judgments of liability from the office of Adjudication are due and owing.
- Any unpaid City liens are on any property owned by the applicant.
- Any outstanding Code violations exist that the homeowner has been advised of and had not corrected.
- The homeowner is not current on any other City obligations; or not in compliance with requirements of the City Code, including but not limited to multi-family licensing, alarm permitting or vacant building registration.

PROCEDURES

The City will undertake this Flood Mitigation Shared Cost Program immediately to assist with flood prevention. The City reserves the right to modify the administration of the Flood Mitigation Program, as well as policies, procedures and rules adopted under this Flood Mitigation Program as a result of the information and experience compiled throughout the program.

The basic steps in the procedure for the overall program are as follows:

1. The homeowner establishes initial intent to participate in the Flood Mitigation Program by contacting the **Engineering Department**, in person or in writing at City Hall, stormwater@ci.berwyn.il.us or fax 708-749-6593. The homeowner will provide their name, address, phone number and e-mail address on a form with the Engineering Department. The form can also be filled out and printed from the City's website at <http://www.berwyn-il.gov/Flood%20Information>

2. The plumbing inspector and/or Engineer will undertake the building inspections to establish the existing conditions and to determine if the property is eligible.

3. If the homeowner is not eligible, the Engineer will notify the homeowner of the reason for the ineligibility. If the reason for the ineligibility is due to an outstanding debt, judgment or code compliance issue, the homeowner will be allowed to satisfy those obligations, come into compliance with the City Code and re-apply. For purposes of determining priority, the homeowner's place in line will be based upon the date of reapplication.

4. After being deemed eligible, the homeowner shall give final notice of intent to participate in the program by signing and returning a completed application packet. The application consists of:

- a) Completed Application Form.
- b) A detailed proposal(s) from an Illinois licensed plumbing contractor(s), which includes technical information on materials, pumps, valves, electrical panels, etc. that will be used on the improvement. The City encourages homeowners to obtain at least three estimates from qualified contractors for this work.

5. The City reviews application packet and formally replies to homeowner of approval or denial. The City's response will identify the portions of the proposed improvement which are eligible and which are not eligible as well as the maximum amount of eligible cost sharing reimbursement.

6. The homeowner shall then authorize the contractor to do the work by executing the contract approved by the City.

7. The contractor shall follow all project requirements, obtain the permit for

construction (permit fees will be waived for items qualifying under this program) and schedule City Inspection visits (inspection fees still apply) as required during construction. The City shall inspect the improvement, maintain records of inspections and approve the final installation.

8. Upon completion of the work, the homeowner shall submit the Request for Reimbursement form, accompanied by the following:

- a) Proof of payment.
- b) Certifications from the contractor that work was completed.
- c) Certification from the City Inspector that the work was completed in accordance in with City Codes and passed final inspection.

9. The Engineer shall review the Request for Reimbursement form, certify the eligible improvement costs and requested reimbursement amount, and forward the approved Request for Reimbursement to the City Finance Department.





EXAMPLE OF A TYPICAL INSTALLATION OF A BACKFLOW PREVENTION VALVE




Re: Sidewalk program status report and recommendation

The 2014 sidewalk replacement program began the last week of October and currently about one third of the program has been completed. After bids were received and bids awarded, I received a copy of the attached letter from the Illinois Road and Transportation Builders Association notifying everyone of the shortage of cement and fly ash this fall. Both of these materials are necessary in the mixture to make concrete.

Our approved contractor, G&M Cement has been attempting to place orders for concrete to continue to keep this project moving. Early in the project, the concrete suppliers would schedule orders several days in advance. This created minor modifications and delays to the schedule. But lately, due to the roadway projects, the concrete suppliers are cancelling the contractors' orders on the day of expected delivery. As of today G&M Cement has had over 400 yards of concrete canceled by the suppliers so far. Because of this, Staff met with the contractor and discussed what options are available and if G&M had any additional communications with any of the concrete suppliers regarding the expectations of this shortage.

After speaking with our concrete supplier and G&M, staff believes that in the best interest of the project, we place the remaining portions of the project on hold until spring. At that time we will resume the sidewalk replacement project for the 2014 program.

Re: Current Cement Supply

Dear Secretary Borggren, Executive Director Lafleur, and Commissioner Scheinfeld:

The State of Illinois is currently experiencing a shortage in the supply of cement. In addition to Illinois, the entire Great Lakes Region is facing this shortage. The Illinois Road & Transportation Builders Association (IRTBA) asks for your thoughtful consideration and appropriate relief for the contracting community, as this situation stems from circumstances beyond their control.

The issues leading to this shortage appear to be primarily logistic and not due to lack of capacity or effort on behalf of the supply and contracting communities. Annual domestic cement manufacturing volume continues to exceed current and projected annual demand. That, coupled with the unusually severe winter, caused the 2015 construction season in Illinois to begin slowly. As a result, the demand for cement is very high as contractors try to complete their project timelines before winter brings their schedule to a halt. This demand has of course resulted in low inventories and a tight supply. Various supply chain disruptions have aggravated the issue, including historic levels of ice on the Great Lakes, delaying the movement of cement from manufacturing to distribution facilities all over the Great Lakes and upper Midwest; rail congestion throughout the Eastern United States, along with a scarcity of rail cars to move cement; disruption of barge traffic by early flooding and later channel maintenance in key parts of the river system; and a short supply of trucks and drivers, as well as a mandate that restricts drivers from more than 60 hours per week.

While the cement industry is attempting to overcome this "perfect storm" of logistic factors that have severely challenged cement suppliers to meet current levels of demand, the aftermath of this storm is unfortunately predicted to result in unavoidable project delays.

Again, IRTBA asks for your understanding and clemency in this matter as the demand for cement continues to grow with the recovery of the construction economy. It is expected that the experience with these logistical hurdles will improve the industry's ability to overcome similar challenges and be better poised to deal with unique problems in future years.

After the completion of the 16 inch water main installation on Oak Park Avenue, staff has completed temporary patches on all the locations where services were transferred. The final step is to mill 3 inches off the surface and re-surface the southbound lane of Oak Park Avenue from 22nd Street to approximately Riverside Drive.

Due to the time of year, I sought price quotes from three different contractors to complete this job. The lowest proposal is attached, from M & J Asphalt Paving for \$2.95 per square foot to remove and replace three inches of asphalt for a total of \$29,942.50. The other proposals were \$3.25 per square foot and \$3.45 per square foot to remove and replace three inches of asphalt.

Therefore, I am requesting to waive the sealed bid process and accept the lowest proposal to complete the re-surfacing in the southbound lane of Oak Park Avenue from 22nd Street to approximately Riverside Drive.

Recommended Actions;

It is my recommendation to waive the sealed bidding process and accept the lowest proposal from M & J Asphalt Paving to remove and replace approximately 10,150 square feet of pavement at \$2.95 per square foot.

The provisions of this Proposal, including but not limited to these Terms and Conditions, shall have priority over any conflicting provision of any other document. No term or condition in any form or other document used or supplied by owner/contractor shall be binding upon M&J unless M&J has specifically consented thereto in writing.

Prior to commencement of the Work, M&J and the owner/contractor shall agree to a project schedule for each phase of the Work. In addition, any work of any other contractor shall be completed to such an extent that it will not in any way conflict or interfere with the Work of M&J. In the event M&J is required or directed to commence the Work prior to the time the work of any other contractor is completed, the owner/contractor hereby agrees to pay any and all costs of additional mobilizations and any other costs or expenses incurred by M&J as a result thereof. In the event M&J is required to mobilize more than one time for each phase of the Work as set forth in the Proposal, due to any acts or omissions of the owner/contractor, owner/contractor hereby agrees to pay \$3,500.00 per mobilization.

In order to meet any agreed upon completion date, M&J must receive from the owner/contractor a ten-day advance notice in writing to proceed.

Owner/contractor hereby acknowledges that the petroleum market is extremely volatile. Therefore, any asphalt or other material price increase from M&J's suppliers between the date of the Proposal and the commencement date of the Work is subject to an escalation clause. Owner/contractor hereby agrees to pay to M&J the material cost increase, including taxes together with a 10% markup on said increase. M&J hereby agrees to provide owner/contractor with documents verifying said increase upon request.

M&J shall not be responsible for any damage to any underground utilities, appurtenances or other hidden conditions unless the owner/contractor has given to M&J advance written notice of their existence and location. Owner/contractor hereby agrees to fully defend, indemnify and hold harmless, M&J for any claim, loss, expense or damage, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or in any way related to such condition.

Any unforeseen or changed condition of the job specifications involving extra costs will be performed by M&J only upon a written change order executed by owner/contractor. It is specifically understood and agreed that M&J shall be under no obligation to perform any such extra work unless and until it receives a fully executed change order from owner/contractor.

Owner/contractor hereby agrees to the following:

- A) The pavement shall have a minimum grade of one percent (1%) for suitable surface drainage. In the event the grade is less than one percent (1%), the owner/contractor, at its sole cost and expense, shall redesign the plan grades and/or take whatever action is necessary in order to establish a minimum grade of one percent (1%). If the subgrade is prepared by owner/contractor, it must be rough graded, compacted to the specified soil compaction limits and proof rolled to within plus/minus 0.10° tolerance.
- C) If the Work involves resurfacing (overlying) existing concrete or asphalt pavement, M&J shall not be responsible, and the warranty provided hereunder shall not apply, to any reflective cracking caused by underlying cracks or expansion joints in the existing concrete or asphalt pavement.
- D) Owner shall provide M&J with suitable ingress and egress to the work site. In the event such ingress and egress is across adjacent parcels of property, it is hereby agreed that M&J shall not be liable for any damage by its trucks or equipment in the performance of the Work. Owner/contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless M&J from any claims, loss, expense or damage resulting from or in any way related to such ingress and egress.



- A) Bonds, permits or fees. If requested by M&J, owner/contractor shall provide evidence that it has made suitable financial arrangements acceptable to M&J to fulfill its payment obligations under this Proposal. In addition, if requested by M&J, owner/contractor shall provide a legal description, project address and such other information and reasonably requested by M&J for use in the event of any necessary collection measures or processing lien documentation.

M&J hereby warrants and guarantees that the work furnished hereunder shall conform to the specifications and requirements as set forth in the Proposal and further warrants and guarantees that the work is free from defects in material and workmanship. This guarantee and warranty shall remain in effect for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of written acceptance of the Work by the owner/contractor. M&J shall promptly, and at its sole cost and expense, either repair or replace any defective work upon receipt by a written notice of a defect within said twelve (12) month period.

The services to be performed by the consulting engineer, pertaining to the various items of work included in the estimated cost of maintenance operations (BLR 14231 or BLR 14221), shall consist of the following:

PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING shall include:

Investigation of the condition of the streets or highways for determination (in consultation with the local highway authority) of the maintenance operations to be included in the maintenance program; preparation of the maintenance resolution, maintenance estimate of cost and, if applicable, proposal; attendance at meetings of the governing body as may reasonably be required; attendance at public letting; preparation of the contract and/or acceptance of BLR 12330 form. The maintenance expenditure statement must be submitted to IDOT within 3 months of the end of the maintenance period.

ENGINEERING INSPECTION shall include:

Furnishing the engineering field inspection, including preparation of payment estimate for contract, material proposal and/or deliver and install proposal and/or checking material invoices of those maintenance operations requiring engineering field inspection, as opposed to those routine maintenance operations as described in Chapter 14-2.04 of BLRS Manual, which may or may not require engineering inspection.

For furnishing preliminary engineering, the engineer will be paid a base fee PLUS a negotiated fee percentage. For furnishing engineering inspection the engineer will be paid a negotiated fee percentage. The negotiated preliminary engineering fee percentage for each group shown in the "Schedule of Fees" shall be applied to the total estimated costs of that group. The negotiated fee for engineering inspection for each group shall be applied to the total final cost of that group for the items which required engineering inspection. In no case shall this be construed to include supervision of contractor operations.

Sir,

I would like to recommend that the following Berwyn Police Officers be recognized at the Berwyn City Council on November 12th, 2014: Sergeant Guy Papa, Tactical Officers Matthew Burke, Vincent Esposito, George Audiffred, Daniel Rodriguez, Detectives Richard Novotny, Charles Schauer, Richard Volanti, Robert Monaco, Canine Officer John Fitzpatrick, Patrol Officers Juan Macias, Joseph Pesa and Timothy Keske.

On Thursday, October 9th, 2014, Patrol Officers Juan Macias and Joseph Pesa responded to a call for service. Upon their arrival they began an investigation into a domestic violence call. In an attempt to control the initial investigation better, they made a decision to detain a suspect, to further some information that was not readily available on the scene (to review the remedies of an Order of Protection). While the subject was in police custody, the officers were able to determine that the suspect actually was not in violation of any Orders of Protections, he advised Officer Macias that he would like to speak with somebody regarding a subject that he knows to deal narcotics and possess firearms. Officer Macias forwarded the information to the Berwyn Police Tactical Unit who became involved in the narcotics investigation based on the information that the subject provided.

As a result of the information that the subject provided, Berwyn Tactical Officers and Detectives began conducting surveillance on the suspected narcotics dealer. Upon conducting their investigation, the officers were able to identify the suspected narcotics dealer as Fernando Gomez, a 20 year old male who is an active member of the 2-2 Boys Street Gang. Additional Information obtained by the Investigators was that Fernando Gomez, the target, had a suspended Illinois driver's license. Officers conducting pre-warrant surveillance observed two males leave the target residence in a silver car that they backed out of the garage. As the vehicle was driving away, officers who were conducting pre-warrant surveillance positively identified Gomez as the driver of a vehicle. Once the target was far

enough away from the residence, the suspect was stopped by Tactical Officer Burke or driving while his driving privileges were suspended. Gomez was subsequently taken into custody at which time during a custodial search, Officer Burke located and recovered a package containing cocaine in the suspect's waist area.


While the suspect Gomez was being taken into custody, additional officers were meeting with an on call Duty Judge who after reviewing the facts of the investigation approved and signed a search warrant authorizing officers to enter the suspect's residence to conduct a search.

At approximately 6:50pm officers were assembled and executed the authorized search warrant at 1330 S. Ridgeland Avenue, the Gomez residence. Upon executing the search warrant the officers located and recovered approximately 20 grams of cocaine, over two thousand seven hundred dollars and 7 firearms with ammunition.

The officers involved in this investigation displayed outstanding team work by forwarding initial information that led to the apprehension of a dangerous active gang member; which resulted in the removal of a violent offender from the streets of Berwyn, thereby making our great city and the citizens much safer.

I have attached a complete pack of the traffic stop arrest and the execution of the search warrant.

Sir,

I would like to recommend that the following Berwyn Police Officers be recognized at the Berwyn City Council on November 12th, 2014: Unit Commanders Frank Cimaglia and Sandro Scardamaglia, Sergeants George Janecek and Thomas Bojovic, Detectives Anthony Gennett, David Green, John Hadjoannou, Karlas Robinzine, Carmelita Terry, Richard Novotny, Charles Schauer, Richard Volanti and Robert Monaco, School Resource Officer Jennifer Stillo, Patrol Officers Juan Macias, Gregory Lill, Armando Rivera, James Schumacher and Manuel Rivera, for outstanding police work and team work.

On Friday, October 10th, 2014, Patrol Officers Juan Macias and Gregory Lill were employed as police officers working within Morton West High School, when they were notified by school administrators that a viral text message was sent through social media avenues, telling people not to come to school that something bad or a shooting was going to happen. While investigating the first viral text message a second message was sent through Snapchat, another social media feed expressing the same type of information, that there was going to be a shooting at Morton West High School at noon. As a result of the circulated message, several students failed to report for school, several parents flooded the school with telephone calls expressing their concerns and interests, and several attending students became upset, afraid and panicky.

Unit working at the school immediately summoned the Patrol Watch Commander and Street Supervisor, advising them of the information being circulated through social media and adverse reaction that the rumors were causing. Responding supervisors Janecek and Bojovic notified Unit Commanders Frank Cimaglia and Sandro Scardamaglia of the situation at which time Detectives were assigned to the school along with additional patrol officers to attempt to restore the school to a safe and peaceful environment.

Responding Detectives worked with school administrators in an attempt to determine who started the rumor causing everyone to panic, become upset, and not come to school or leave school without permission. Through the investigation, Detectives were able to identify two independent individuals who were responsible for sending both messages out through social media feeds. Both offenders are minors, so their information is not accessible or releasable; however, both minors have been petitioned into the Juvenile Court System for a felony criminal charge of Disorderly Conduct.

The officers involved in both of these investigations displayed professional, outstanding team work that led to the apprehension of two minors who were responsible for creating panic, mayhem and in some cases hysteria in a public school system. In addition to criminal charges that were filed against both minors, Morton West High School Administrators also took discipline sanctions against the minor offenders.

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES FOR THE 2015 FISCAL YEAR IN THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the “Home Rule Powers”); and

WHEREAS, the City contracts with a private waste collection and disposal company, Waste Management, to provide weekly garbage collection for residential dwellings less than five units; and

WHEREAS, the City administers the collection of all such customer accounts and provides applicable billing invoices, accounting services and expends other public funds to administer the solid waste billing and collection program; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management has given the City notice that rates charged for garbage collection will be increasing by 2.0% commencing in 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that the City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, adopts the amended billing fee rate adjustment as established by Waste Management for weekly garbage collection in the 2015 calendar year as set forth below:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Fees for the collection and billing of all solid waste disposal services are hereby adjusted by an increase of 2.0% commencing on the billing cycle beginning on January 1, 2015.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby amended or repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: Any non-preemptive state statute in conflict hereof with the ordinance is hereby superseded to the full extent of such conflict pursuant to the exercise of the Home Rule Powers of the City.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law to be effective by January 1, 2015.

Subject: Proposed 2014 Tax Levy (to be collected in 2015)

The State of Illinois' Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/18-60), states that an estimate of taxes to be levied is to be determined by the corporate authority of each taxing body not less than 20 days prior to the adoption of its aggregate levy. The aggregate levy for the City of Berwyn, per the Illinois Property Tax Code, includes the levies for corporate and special purposes. Debt service levies are not included in the aggregate levy. The chart below lists the intended aggregate levy for the 2014 tax year in comparison to the 2013 tax year:

A Truth in Taxation hearing will NOT be required because the proposed 2014 tax levy only exceeds the 2013 tax levy by less than 1%. Per the State of Illinois' Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/18-70), a notice and hearing are required for an estimate that is more than 5% of the amount extended or estimated to be extended upon the final aggregate levy for the preceding year. The slight increase in the aggregate levy is being done to maintain City services without depleting the City's reserve funds.

The City's total debt service levy for 2014 totals \$10,347,042, compared to \$10,138,923 in 2013. This represents a 2.1% increase in the total debt service levy.
