

Total By Day of Week









Significant Incidents

- Death Investigation – September 18, 2020

Loyola MacNeal Hospital

Officers responded regarding an unresponsive subject being dropped off in the pick-up/drop-off area. It was learned from the male subject who had transported the 23 year old female victim to the hospital that he had met her on Snapchat just hours before. The male agreed to meet the female at a bar in Stone Park. The couple traveled to a strip club also in Stone Park. After being denied entry, the 2 walked back to his vehicle where the female began to get lethargic and became unconscious in the back seat. The male drove the female to the hospital where she was pronounced dead. Incident documented and being investigated.




- Residential Burglary – September 15, 2020

6900 30th Place

Victim came home and discovered a window screen cut and the A/C unit pushed in. While waiting for police to arrive, she observed her daughters ex-boyfriend fleeing the back yard on a bike. Bike was recovered in the alley a couple doors away. Entry was made to the house, but nothing reported missing at this time.

Significant Incidents

- Discharge of a Firearm – September 20, 2020

Roosevelt and Highland

Officers were dispatched for a call of shots fired. An Oak Park Sergeant heard 3 shots and located casings. A male on a bike was seen in the South Roosevelt alley at the same time the shots were fired. There were no victims or further information.

- Disturbance – September 20, 2020

6312 Cermak Road

Security from Canton 8 called in that a subject in the rear was attempting to enter with a small black gun. The subjects were advised they could not enter. Officers arrived on scene and detained 3 subjects, 2 male and 1 female. A search was conducted and a magazine with 9mm rounds was found in the females waist band. A 9mm Springfield Armory Hellcat was also located. All 3 subjects transported to the station. A LEADS check of the gun revealed the gun to be stolen. 1 male subject is on parole for armed robbery. 1 male subject is a prior parolee. All three subjects highly intoxicated and placed on hold.



Significant Incidents

- Battery – September 15, 2020

18th and Oak Park

Female was walking in the 1800 block of Oak Park when a Male Hispanic riding a black bike slapped her on her buttocks and started yelling lewd obscene comments at her. Offender last seen North Bound Grove from 18th Street. Victim can ID and will sign complaints.

- Hit and Run – September 16, 2020

18th and Oak Park

Stolen vehicle out of Oak Park struck a pick-up truck causing the pick-up to run over a stop sign on the NE corner of 18th and Oak park. The offending vehicle fled and was later found unoccupied near 19th and Oak Park. Suspect was located and taken into custody for drug possession charge. He was later released without charges as no one, including the victim of the hit and run and 2 witnesses, could ID him.



Ward 7



For week of 9/14/2020

Significant Incidents

- Armed Robbery – September 16, 2020 - 6601 W. Roosevelt Rd.

Units responded to the 7-11 store regarding an armed robbery. It was learned that the store was robbed by a Male Black subject wearing a black hoody, black face covering, black pants with a red stripe and black gym shoes. Subject entered the store, displayed a black handgun and demanded money. Subject fled E/B through the South Roosevelt alley.

- U UW Investigation – September 17, 2020 - 14th and Elmwood Ave.

Several officers conducted a traffic stop for a traffic violation. The driver was identified (currently on electric monitoring for a previous weapons charge), 2 adult passengers identified (one of which currently on bond for a previous weapons charge) and 1 juvenile passenger identified. Recovered from the vehicle were 2 Glock firearms. Both firearms had a round chambered and fully loaded magazines. All 3 adults held pending approval of felony charges. Juvenile was charged and petitioned and transferred to Juvenile Detention Center.

- Officer Involved Shooting – September 19, 2020 - Roosevelt and Ridgeland

Officers conducted a traffic stop at the Shell Gas Station. The vehicle reversed into one of the squad cars. The vehicle then accelerated forward directly at an Officer getting out of another squad car. That Officer was struck on the leg and fired 3 rounds from their service weapon. The vehicle fled the scene West on Roosevelt at a high rate of speed. The vehicle was last seen near the intersection of Ogden and LaGrange. The Officer was brought to MacNeal Hospital and was released with a leg injury.
