



Total Items For Service



Significant Incidents

- Threat – September 27, 2020 – Ogden & Home
Units responded to Junior's Bar and Grill for a customer making threats to staff. Upon arrival, met with subject who stated he was thrown out of the bar. Officers then talked with the caller who related subject stated to her that he could have her killed. Subject then attempted to antagonize another patron of the bar and was then escorted out of the bar. Medical and complaint refusals signed.
- Stolen Auto – September 21, 2020 – 35th and Euclid
Taken from the rear of 35th and Euclid. Red 2015 Cadillac. Ohio plate.




Significant Incidents

- Battery – September 21, 2020 – 6736 W. Cermak

Officers responded to the establishment in regards to a fight inside where the involved parties were escorted out by the Security Staff. Victim related he was punched in the face by the Offender after asking a couple patrons to give the drummer in the band some room to play. Offender was placed into custody and charged with one count of Battery.



Ward 3



For week of 9/14/2020

Significant Incidents

- Aggravated Battery – September 24, 2020 – 26th and Clarence

Units responded to a report of a fight. Upon arrival, Officers stopped two separate groups of people at 26th and Clarence and two others behind the Health Department. The two behind the Health Department were determined to be the victims as one was stabbed several times. Officers used three compression bandages to assist the bleeding on the victim. The two other subjects stopped were determined to be the offenders and were taken into custody. Though the two victims knew the offenders personally, a show up was conducted with the uninjured victim who identified both subjects as being involved. 2 knives were recovered and submitted into evidence.

- Criminal Defacement – September 23, 2020 – 26th and East

While on patrol, two officers located five different locations that had been vandalized. The five locations consisted of three residential garages, the former Red Top hot dog stand and Hiawatha School. The graffiti was applied with black in color spray paint and was all gang-related. No known offenders at the present time.

- Accident – September 21, 2020 – 26th and East Avenue

Driver found unresponsive behind the wheel of his pickup after striking a parked vehicle and the front steps of a residence. FD had to break the window to gain access and Paramedics immediately began CPR. He was transported to MacNeal Hospital where he is currently on life support.

Significant Incidents

- Hit and Run – September 21, 2020 – 24th and Ridgeland


Units responded for a Hit and Run accident in which the offending vehicle, a silver Toyota Prius was last seen Southbound on Ridgeland from the scene. Officers observed the vehicle and attempted to stop the vehicle, at which time the vehicle failed to stop and sped off Southbound Ridgeland to Eastbound Ogden. The Officers were able to obtain the license plate which came back stolen out of Chicago. The vehicle was last seen Eastbound on Ogden at 50th Ct. in Cicero at speeds in excess of 60 MPH and driving into oncoming traffic. Officers were advised to terminate pursuit. Cicero PD contacted Berwyn Central Dispatch and advised this vehicle was wanted by their department for an attempted vehicular hijacking at 47th and Roosevelt. Victim can ID the driver and can make a composite sketch.

- Shots Fired – September 21, 2020 – Cuyler and Vacin Fairway

Officers responded to the area of Canton 8 in regards to 3-4 shots fired. Officers located a vehicle matching the description given by witnesses which was parked and occupied with one male subject and one female subject. Officers were granted consent to search the vehicle which was met with negative results in locating a weapon or any contraband. Incident documented accordingly.



Significant Incidents

- Battery – September 27, 2020 – 6800 Cermak


Dispatched to El Nuevo Vallarta’s parking lot in reference to a fight. Upon arrival, intoxicated subjects were separated and Uber transport was summoned. While waiting, one subject began to get irate then poked an Officer with his index finger on his upper right chest. Subject was advised to refrain from any further contact, at which time he poked the Officer in the chest a second time. Subject was then handcuffed and placed into custody. Subject began screaming expletives at Officers and was highly uncooperative. Subject was processed and charged with one misdemeanor count Battery.

- Armed Robbery – September 21, 2020 – 19th and Harlem

Officers responded to the area in regards to an armed robbery where the victims keys, cellphone and vehicle were taken. The victim was parking when he was approached by 3-4 male black subjects who exited a vehicle. One of the subjects brandished a firearm at which time the victim relinquished his keys and cellphone. Offenders then stole the victims vehicle and fled the area. With the assistance of On-Star, Officers were able to locate and recover the vehicle which was unoccupied in the area of Keeler and Altgeld, Chicago.

Significant Incidents

- City Casualty – September 24, 2020 – Roosevelt and Oak Park

No injuries. Squad patrolling stopped at stop light E/B Roosevelt and Oak Park Avenue when he was rear ended. As Officer exited and called out the plate, the offender fled the scene. A short chase ensued but eventually terminated as offender exceeded 90 MPH per radar. Offender disobeyed all traffic controls and was driving into oncoming traffic. Vehicle can be identified by Officer and was last seen E/B 16th Street from Austin Blvd.

- Stolen Auto – September 21, 2020 – Harlem and Roosevelt

Caller left vehicle running and unattended with keys in the car. He last observed his vehicle headed NB on Harlem towards the I-290 Expressway. Vehicle is a 2014 Ford Focus Sedan, Grey in color. It is believed that the offender exited from a white SUV, offender described as male black, black hat.
