





Total Items For Service






**Significant Incidents**

- Hit and Run Traffic Crash – September 30, 2020 – 23<sup>rd</sup> and Wesley Avenue

Officers responded to the area in regards to a Hit and Run where they found the vehicle unoccupied. Apparently, the driver fled the scene on foot leaving the keys in the ignition, leaving 2 cell phones behind and an open bottle of whiskey on the rear seat. Prior to completion on the Traffic Crash investigation, the registered owner of the vehicle attempted to report a carjacking with Cicero PD over the telephone. CPD would not take that type of report over the telephone, at which time the transferred the call to Berwyn Central Dispatch. The registered owner was taken into custody pending further investigation and ultimately admitted that he made up the carjacking story and put himself inside the vehicle at the time of the traffic crash. Subject processed accordingly and issued multiple citations.


**Significant Incidents**

- Apartment Fire/D.O.A. – October 1, 2020 – Cermak and Highland

Units were dispatched in reference to smoke in the building with activated fire alarms within the building. Upon arrival of Police and Fire units, smoke and fire was observed from the top floor of the building. Evacuation was immediately conducted and fire suppression was initiated. After entry was made to top floor apartment, the single deceased subject was identified and cause of death appeared to be smoke inhalation. Fire Marshal arrived on scene and determined to the cause of the fire was due to an electrical issue.

## For week of 9/28/2020

### Significant Incidents

- Shots Fired – October 5, 2020 – 18<sup>th</sup> and Clarence

While assisting with another call, Officers heard 4 shots which appeared to be S/E of 13<sup>th</sup> and Wenonah. Moments later, Berwyn Central Dispatch related they received a call of shots fired from a resident in the area of 18<sup>th</sup> and Clarence. Officers were unable to narrow down the area and Berwyn Central Dispatch received no additional calls. Incident documented accordingly.

- Disturbance – October 2, 2020 – Cermak and Elmwood


Officers dispatched to a disturbance at Old Time's Sake. The caller related the resident above the bar threw a ceramic pot out of the window. Caller stated this is an ongoing issue and believes the resident suffers from some type of mental health issue. Officers made contact with the resident who stated she placed the pot outside her window to water her plants while it was raining and it accidentally fell from the ledge. Resident was highly uncooperative. Due to this being an ongoing issue, caller would like the incident documented.

- Car Fire/Arson – October 1, 2020 – 18<sup>th</sup> and Ridgeland

Units were dispatched for a car fire. Upon arrival, the vehicle (tan Chevy Malibu) with an engulfed rag stuffed into a hole which was made in the rear driver side window. Stickney FD arrived and extinguished the fire. Only damage was to the window and passenger door. Video was obtained which shows 3 males standing next to vehicle and running S/B through the alley behind victims apartment. Vehicle towed and placed on hold for Berwyn Fire Investigator.

## **Significant Incidents**

- Attempt Criminal Sexual Assault/ Strong Armed Robbery – October 3, 2020 – Cermak and Kenilworth


Units were dispatched to Cermak and Kenilworth for a call of a Robbery at Herbalife. Upon arrival, it was ascertained that an attempt sexual assault occurred. Victim related that the offender exposed himself to her and then went behind the counter and dragged her by the neck to the center of the store. He then pulled her pants down and scratched her face as she was fighting him off of her. The offender then stopped, got up to leave, then turned and forcefully took her cell phone which contained her identification and bank card. Offender described as a M/B, 45 YOA, thin build, 5'7"-5'8", with eyeglasses, wearing a black shirt and blue jeans. Units searched the area but were unable to locate the offender.

- Armed Bank Robbery – September 29, 2020 - 7100 W. Cermak

Units responded to a report of a bank robbery at Fifth Third Bank. Upon arrival, the units were advised that the offender had fled on foot. The offender had entered the bank twice, the first time he took a deposit slip and wrote on it, then left. Approximately 15-20 minutes later, he returned and demanded money while displaying a handgun. The offender also advised no dye packs. The offender handed over a note and demanded \$20,000 USC. Fifth Third Bank gave the subject and undisclosed amount of USC with no dye pack or trackers. The offender placed the money into a black in color cloth bag and then placed it into his backpack. He was last seen travelling NB on Wisconsin across the Vacin Fairway. Subject description: M/B, 16-20 YOA, average build, 5'6"-5'7". Wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a "Champion" brand logo, a black backpack, black pants, black shoes and a black bandana style face mask. Offender was not wearing gloves. Subject spoke in a high pitched voice.


- Reckless Discharge of Firearm – October 5, 2020 – 12<sup>th</sup> and Wenonah

Officers responded in regards to shots fired called in to Berwyn Central Dispatch by 3 separate callers, only one of whom was willing to speak. Officers conducted a check of the area and located 6 spent 9mm shell casings lying in the street. Officers were supplied with video of the incident from a resident. The video shows 2 subjects riding on bicycles S/B Wenonah. One of the subjects appears to fire a handgun into the air. No known victims or obvious property damage and no signs of a disturbance prior to the incident. Incident documented accordingly.

- Vandalism – September 30, 2020 – 13<sup>th</sup> and Wisconsin

On the 1300 block of Wisconsin. 1400 block of Wenonah and 7000 block of 14<sup>th</sup> Street – Officers responded to the area in regards to approximately 25-30 vehicles that appear to have been struck with orange in color paintballs sometime overnight.
