





Significant Incidents

- Armed Robbery – October 9, 2020 – 36th and Clinton Ave.

Manager from Dominos called to report his driver was robbed during a delivery by 2 male subjects with a small handgun. The driver left the scene and did not report this incident at that time causing at least a 10 minute delay. The 2 offenders were last seen on foot Northbound Clinton and are described as follows: Subject #1 M/H 5'8" medium build, blue eyes, thin mustache, black hoody, blue jeans. Subject #2 M/H 5'8" medium build, black hoody, black jeans, armed with a small handgun. No injuries reported and multiple Ring doorbells and cameras located in the area.


Significant Incidents

- Road Rage Incident/Gunshot Victim – October 10, 2020 – Ogden and Ridgeland

Units were dispatched to MacNeal Hospital in regards to a walk-in gunshot wound victim. During the investigation it was learned that the victim had a road rage incident with another vehicle. The offender pulled along side the victims vehicle and fired one shot into the drivers side door. The bullet travelled through the door and lodged into the outer layer of the victims stomach. Offending vehicle is alleged to be a Maroon Chrysler 300 occupied by one male black and one female black.


Significant Incidents

- Death Investigation – October 7, 2020 – 6800 block of Ogden

Officers observed a male laying on top of a flower bed and was observed to be not breathing. The on view officer and responding EMS attempted life saving efforts but male was later pronounced deceased at MacNeal Hospital. There were no obvious signs of trauma and Male has an extensive medical history on top of alcohol abuse.

Significant Incidents

- After Hours Ordinance Violation – October 12, 2020 – Cermak and Cuyler

Officers responded to Canton 8 in regards to an abandoned 911 call. Officers arrived on scene at approximately 0120 hours and found the business to still be open, serving drinks and the band was still playing. The manager confirmed that there were no issues inside the establishment and was under the impression that they could stay open for an extra hour due to the holiday (Indigenous Peoples Day). Officers advised him that this particular holiday is not included in the ordinance and that he must shut down immediately. Local Ordinance citation issued with a must appear adjudication hearing date.

- Shots Fired – October 10, 2020 – 16th and Cuyler


Officers met with a complainant who advised that he heard 5 loud pop sounds between 0400 and 0500 hours on today's date but he believed the noise to be fireworks so he never called the PD. This morning he observed 5 shell casings located in the alley behind his residence. 5 9mm shell casings were recovered and placed into evidence locker. Also noted by officer were two locations with cameras in the alley.

- Tavern Check – October 8, 2020 – 6319 Roosevelt

A concerned caller called in regards to Big Mike's Tavern in which caller alleged COVID violations. Units arrived on scene, patrons were adhering to the mask requirements. However, there was approximately 75 occupants inside. The proprietor related that he is allowed 50 in each room along with an additional 35 outside. He related he spoke with the health department earlier today and that is what he is allowed. Report was written to be followed up.



Ward 5



For week of 10/05/2020

Significant Incidents

- Aggravated Revoked/Resisting – October 10, 2020 – 6400 Ridgeland Ave.

Officers dispatched to abandoned 911 call to the rear of Bank of America. Upon arrival, officers observed a make subject sleeping inside of a running vehicle. Subject was uncooperative and under the influence of suspected drugs and alcohol. Subject ignored orders to exit the vehicle and anchored his body in the driver compartment by pressing his feet to the floor and his back against the chair. He was subsequently assisted out of the vehicle and taken into custody. At Berwyn Central subject refused to be processed and was placed in cell pending charges.

- Stolen Auto – October 9, 2020 – 6733 W. Cermak


Units responded regarding a stolen auto. Victim related that he left his vehicle running and went into the business. A person(s) unknown entered his 1995 white Toyota Corolla and drove off with his vehicle. Vehicle entered into LEADS as being stolen.

- Shots Fired – October 5, 2020 – 18th and Clarence

While assisting with a canvas on a separate incident, officers heard an additional 4 gun shots which appeared to be S/E of 13th and Wenonah. Moments later BCD related they received a call of shots fired from a resident. The caller confirmed hearing approximately 4 shots just North of her residence. Incident documented accordingly.



Ward 6

Significant Incidents

- Commercial Burglary– October 11, 2020– 7140 W. Roosevelt

Officers responded to Chipolte in regards to a M/B subject attempting to break in being called in by the alarm company. Upon arrival, Officers located an unsecured front door and immediately set up a perimeter around the building. There were no signs of forced entry to the front doors. Officers on scene related that they observed a M/B subject on the interior who initially ducked behind a wall and then exited on his own accord. The subject was then detained, secured in hand restraints and searched at which time a large knife and a cordless phone (both items belonging to the business) were found on his person. Subject placed on hold for the Criminal Investigations Unit.

- CDP & Battery – October 11, 2020 – 6806 W. Cermak Rd.


While on patrol, Officer observed a M/H subject shove another M/H subject through a large pane glass window of the establishment. Officer detained the offender and found that the two subjects know each other and were both highly intoxicated. The offender was placed into custody and BFD paramedics were summoned due to the victim sustaining lacerations to both of his hands. Property owner wishes to pursue charges and was advised to get an estimate for the damage. Victim did not wish to pursue charges but refused to sign BPD complaint refusal.

- Stolen Motor Vehicle – October, 8, 2020 - 21st and Kenilworth

Victim reported car was stolen. Vehicle is a Silver 2012 Suzuki SX4.

Significant Incidents


- Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm – October 10, 2020 – 13th and Wenonah

Officers dispatched to the area for an anonymous call of 5 shots fired. A search of the area revealed five 9mm shell casings. Further investigation showed no signs of victims or damage, however, graffiti was observed on a garage at 12th and Wisconsin. Cameras were located in the area and properly documented. No offender information or witnesses at this time.

- Reckless Discharge of Firearm – October 5, 2020 – 13th and Wenonah

Officers responded in regards to shots fired. Berwyn Central Dispatch related there were 3 separate callers, 2 who refused to speak and 1 who is willing to speak. Officers conducted a check of the area and located 6 spent 9mm shell casings in the street. A canvas of the area located multiple potential cameras, including the resident who is willing to speak, who supplied officers with video of the incident. The video shows 2 subjects riding on bicycles S/B Wenonah in the 1300 block, and one of the subjects appears to fire a handgun into the air. There is one witness that related that 2 subjects rode down his block and one of them shot multiple times into the air. No known victim or obvious property damage and this time. Casings photographed and recovered, incident documented accordingly.
