Dear Residents & Property Owners,

I am pleased to inform you that the water main servicing your area has been scheduled to be replaced. Funding for the project has been made possible through the City of Berwyn Community Development Department.

Construction is scheduled to begin on **Wednesday October 10, 2018** and is expected to be completed by November 20, 2018 (weather permitting). Normal construction hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with occasional work extending into the evening and on some Saturdays. This will require closing the street to parking and traffic during construction hours. No parking signs will be posted by the contractor and we ask that residents comply with these restrictions to expedite the construction.

There will also be occasions during construction when residents will temporarily lose water service for short periods of time. If water service disruption is necessary, you will be notified in advance via separate correspondence from the City's Public Works Department. Please be assured that these operations are scheduled to minimize inconveniences as much as possible.

Upon completion of the water main installation, the street will be resurfaced and portions of the curb and gutter, and sidewalk will be replaced. Parkways will also be restored.

Your understanding and cooperation during all phases of construction is appreciated and will directly contribute to the completion of the project.

Attached to this notice is information that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency requires the City of Berwyn to provide to residents that are affected by the project.
