1200 Block of Wenonah Avenue

Berwyn, IL- At approximately 2:35am on May 2nd, 2021, Berwyn Police Officers responded to a call of shots fired in the area of 13th Street and Wenonah Ave in Berwyn. The caller advised that a vehicle had rolled over and a subject inside the vehicle was shot.

Upon arriving on scene, the officers discovered a vehicle rolled over, just north of the 13th Street on Wenonah Avenue. The vehicle appeared to be driven by Brandon L. Corbin, a Berwyn resident. Mr. Corbin's wife was a passenger in the vehicle. It was discovered that Mr. Corbin suffered from one gunshot wound to his head. Both parties were transported to a Hospital in the area and are currently undergoing treatment.

Information received on scene is that several unidentified males approached Mr. Corbin's vehicle in the south Roosevelt Road alley at Wenonah Avenue. There was conversation between the unidentified males and Mr. Corbin. As Mr. Corbin drove away, southbound down Wenonah Avenue, several gunshots were fired in the direction of Mr. Corbin's vehicle. One of the gun shots struck Mr. Corbin in the head. Mr. Corbin's vehicle continued southbound on Wenonah Avenue, striking several parked vehicles, causing it to roll over on Wenonah Avenue just north of the 13th Street intersection.

Investigators along with assisting officers from West Suburban Major Crimes Task Force are currently processing all evidence. This investigation is still in its beginning stages and no additional information is available at this moment.
