**City of Berwyn Response to Calls for Internal Investigation of Employee Disciplinary
Actions Involving Building Department Blight Officer**

Disciplinary actions are confidential under union bylaws; however, due to the extraordinary circumstance at hand and acting in good faith and transparency, we can confirm that the City employee involved in an incident on May 11th, 2022, while performing her work duties as a City Blight Officer, **has been terminated** concluding a full investigation in accordance with the due process rights extended to all collective bargaining employees.

The City of Berwyn would like to be clear: the actions and statements made by this former employee do not reflect the values of the City's diverse workforce or work environment in any way and have no place in our City.

The City of Berwyn unequivocally condemns all forms of discrimination and racism and denounces those actions.

We are a proud Welcoming City and will take action to provide employees with resources to help heal those impacted in an effort to foster an inclusive and productive workforce to serve all constituents with dignity, respect and professionalism.
